



% of Population earning \$200,000 or more 2019



TAMPA'S HIGH-INCOME EARNERS SKEW THE AVERAGE.






Median Household Income 2019 Benchmark cities


Income Disparity Between Average Male & Female Full Time Worker, 2018

Per Capita Income Disparity Between African American and Caucasian, 2018



% of Population In Middle Class










Homeownership Rate, 2018


African American Homeownership Rate, 2018


Violent Crime Rate (per 100,000) 2019

% With Bachelors Degree 2019




